## Axon

Axon Enterprise, Inc., was the successful bidder during a public auction of State Trust land at the southeast corner of Hayden Road and Loop 101 in Scottsdale. The 73.57-acre parcel's final bid price was \$49.1million.

Axon has been headquartered in Scottsdale since 1993. The new land acquisition sets the stage for them to build a new, state-of-the-art facility where the company can continue to produce dynamic products that are helping to shape the future of law enforcement.

In August, the Scottsdale City Council approved an infrastructure reimbursement agreement with Axon contingent on the firm's successful bid for the parcel. Axon will build an expanded corporate campus on the site – approximately 250,000 square feet over the next five years to accommodate 1,500 employees.

#### REIMBURSE SCOTTSDALE

As a component of the CARES-Act funds, the Scottsdale Small Business Reimbursement Program looked to reimburse businesses for COVID-19 protection costs. Businesses who submitted proper documentation of purchases related to supplies and equipment needed to keep their employees and customers safe were reimbursed. Under this program over 190 applications were approved and a total of \$625,011.42 was reimbursed to Scottsdale-based businesses.
